**At this time the beaches are scheduled to be closed through April 6, 2020.**

**This closure could change at any time.**

#### **We Are Open**

At this time, we have not encountered any issues related to the disease at Camaron Cove Resort. In an abundance of caution and in compliance with the State of Florida's social distancing guidelines, the Board of Directors is immediately suspending all Beach Club privileges, welcome breakfasts and hot dog luncheons until further notice. In addition, we recommend social distancing in the common areas, by the pool, in the elevator and stairwells. At this time, The beaches on Indian Rocks Beach remain open.

#### **We're Prepared**

As a standard practice, public areas and Units at our resorts are regularly cleaned, sanitized and disinfected. Our teams use disinfectant products, which kill most harmful microorganisms like bacteria and viruses. In addition, the following new protocols are in place to limit contact and exposure:

- Staff will be wearing gloves during their work duties.
- Staff will instruct owners if they wish to have replacement towels and supplies brought in to the unit or left outside in a clean basket.
